ORDINANCE 1929

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 1902 CREATING THE PLAN FOR THE USE OF THE FUNDS ACCOUNTED FOR IN THE ARP CORONAVIRUS LOCAL FISCAL RECOVERY FUND (2403)

WHEREAS, The Town Council adopted Ordinance 1826 creating the ARP Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Fund (176) at their meeting of May 17, 2021; and,

WHEREAS, Ordinance 1826 and the American Rescue Plan (ARP) requires the adoption of a plan for how the monies will be spent; and,

WHEREAS, The Town Council adopted Ordinance 1839 on October 4, 2021, establishing the plan for how a portion of the proceeds would be spent; and,

WHEREAS. The plan can be modified after its creation; and,

WHEREAS, The Town Council amended the plan with Ordinance 1863 on June 6, 2022, and with Ordinance 1902 on May 15, 2023; and,

WHEREAS, Allowable uses of the ARP monies include revenue replacement for the provision of government services including purchases of equipment for public safety purposes; and,

WHEREAS, The Town Council has determined that a portion of the ARP proceeds be spent on new portable radios for the Munster Fire Department, upgrades to the Main Meeting Room of Town Hall, and the balance be spent on LED street lights; now, therefore, be it,

ORDAINED, By the Town Council of the Town of Munster, Lake County, Indiana, that the Plan for the ARP funds will be as follows and in accordance with Section 603 of the American Recovery Plan Act.

- 1. \$500,000.00 will be used by the Department of Parks and Recreation for the provision of governmental purposes as allowed under the revenue replacement section of the law.
- 2. \$1,100,000.00 will be used for the purchase of a new fire engine as allowed under the revenue replacement section of the law and as further explained in the Interim Final Rule of the Treasury Department which allows for "...the provision of police, fire, and other public safety services."
- 3. \$2,500,000.00 will be used for improvements to water infrastructure as allowed under the revenue replacement section of the law as allowed under the United States Department of Treasury Final Rule.
- 4. \$455,070.34 will be used for the purchase of portable radios for the police department as approved by Council at the April 17, 2023, meeting.
- 5. \$539,330.53 will be used for the purchase of portable radios for the fire department.
- 6. Any remaining balance will be allocated at a future date.

ADOPTED AND PASSED this 18th day of December 2023, by a vote of <u>5</u> in favor and <u>0</u> opposed.
