At the Clerk-Treasurer's office, we're committed to making your experience with us as convenient and flexible as possible. Your feedback matters, and we've listened!

WE LISTENED AND YOU HAVE OPTIONS

In response to your requests for fewer paper bills, we partnered with Invoice Cloud to offer an alternative. Munster residents have the option to go paperless and receive their monthly utility bill electronically, along with the link to our informative "News You Can Use."

Here are some noteworthy statistics from our 2023:

- 20% of our customers are enjoying the convenience of paperless billing.
- 24% have opted to pay their utility bills online.
- 14% of customers have enrolled in Invoice Cloud autopay, even with a small fee.
- 400 utility customers were prenoted in the last half of 2023. These customers switched bank accounts, signed up for new service, or began utilizing our FREE direct Autopay through the Town of Munster.
- In December 2023, the Town of Munster had 8,621 utility accounts billed and 3,284 or 38% were ACH customers.

You can pay your bill in our office and the red drop box is a fixture in the Town Hall parking lot, we have found the mail is the option that most of our residents use. We understand everyone has their preferred way of handling bills, whether it's in-person, by mail, online, or through automated options, we're here to accommodate your bill-paying lifestyle.

I usually look at past issues of "News You Can Use" for inspiration for the current article. 
SNOW REMOVAL ORDINANCES

Public Works would like to remind residents of the Town of Munster's ordinances for snow removal.

- 1. Parking is prohibited on all streets in Town after two inches of snowfall.
- 2. Residents are responsible for removing snow from sidewalks within 24 hours after any snowfall.
- 3. It is unlawful to push snow, slush, or ice onto any street or sidewalk.

If you believe that a residence or business is not following these ordinances, please contact either the Munster Police Department by calling nonemergency (219)660-0001 or you can report the matter to Code Enforcement at (219)836-6659. If the situation is an extreme safety concern, always call 911.



ELECTRONIC RECYCLING

Homewood Disposal Service does not pick-up electronics or televisions. Electronics such as personal computers, laptops, printers, cell phones, DVD players and televisions can be

brought to the electronic recycling shed located at 508 Fisher Street. The recycling shed is now located inside of the gate at the Public Works facility, the hours are Monday through Friday from 7:00 am - 3 pm. There is not an attendant. Electronic Recycling is available for Lake County residents only and not for non-profits, businesses or schools.




- Stay at least 50 ft. behind snowplows.

2024 CENTENNIAL PARK PARKING REGISTRATION

Town of Munster residents can register up to 2 vehicles per household to park for free at Centennial Park for the 2024 parking

season. Registration will begin on March 1, 2024 at www.centennialparkvehiclereg.com. Previous registration will not carry over to 2024. Registration can also be done at the Parks and Recreation office at Munster Town Hall. Once a vehicle is registered and a confirmation email is received after proof of residency is confirmed, that vehicle is safe to park at Centennial Park without receiving a notice violation.

Parking fees are effective and will be enforced from April 1-October 31, 2024. If a vehicle is not registered for a free pass and fees are not paid, license plate reading technology will be used to issue notice violations via the mail. Park visitors using the golf course or golf driving range can validate parking inside the Pro Shop but must be done immediately after parking.

Unregistered vehicles have a 15-minute grace period from when they enter the parking lot to either leave the parking lot or to pay at one of the meters or via the ParkByApp app on a smartphone. Credit/debit cards are the only forms of payment accepted. For more information, please visit the Town's website at www.munster.org.


