Town of Munster July 4th Parade

Please bring your family & friends to the Town of Munster Annual July 4th Parade. Every year the Munster community comes together to create a one of a kind memorable experience for everyone involved and or attending. The parade starts at 2:00 p.m. on Thursday, July 4th at the corner of Fisher St. and Calumet Ave. Parade will proceed north on Calumet Ave. to Ridge Rd., then east and stopping briefing at the reviewing stand at Munster Town Hall. The parade will then continue east and end at The Center for Visual and Performing Arts building.



Munster Ordinance 1360: States that consumer fireworks may be discharged within the corporate limits from June 29th through July 3rd and from July 5th through July 9th between the hours of 5:00 pm and two hours after sunset. On July 4th between the hours of 10:00 am and twelve midnight.

And on December 31st from 10:00 pm until January 1st at 1:00 am. A violation of the Town Ordinance carries a fine of \$100.00 per violation.

DRAIN GRATES

Spring rains can cause flooding of yards and streets. Most of the time flooding can be prevented by making sure the

drain grates are kept free of debris. It doesn't take much to clog a drain and have it cause significant flooding of streets and/or yards. As material such as leaves, twigs, and litter are washed from the ground surface it collects onto the drain grating and acts like a rubber plug. The flow of water runoff into the drainage system is drastically reduced when material collects near or on the drain grate. Residents can do their part by helping keep drains near your home free of debris.
