Re: Centennial Park Stairway and Erosion Project Change Order

The Centennial Park Stairway plans specify that the ropes are to be fed through a drill hole and bolted into the side of the upright posts. This design works great and looks very attractive from afar, but it looks quite plain up close. The Director of Parks and Recreation asked for some options to spruce up the ends of the ropes. The best suggestion was to add some decorative rope hooks to the posts and to add steel caps to the ends of the ropes. This inexpensive solution simply prevents the ends of the ropes from fraying and it gives them a nice, finished look. Included in the agenda are pictures of the existing ropes and examples of the finish hardware.

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of Parks and Recreation approve the change order to the Centennial Park Stairway and Erosion Project in the amount of \$800.00
