SUBJECT: Paving Forest/Hohman Alley from Broadmoor Avenue to Beverly Place

DATE: November 18, 2019

Background

On October 18th the following five contractors were invited to quote on a paving project on part of the Forest/Hohman Alley North of Broadmoor Avenue: Walsh & Kelly, Site Services, Holland Asphalt Services, Rieth-Riley, and Gallagher Asphalt.

This project will address the disturbed area that was a result of Gatlin's remediation of the sink hole caused by a sanitary sewer inflow.

Only one quote for paving the partial alley was received by Site Services at \$34,699. Site Services then offered to do the entire alley for \$58,330 (revised proposal attached), the same price that it just completed a similar alley for in late September (between Forest Ave & State Line from Broadmoor Avenue to Beverly Place).

Methodology

The RFQ required that paving should be completed by December 1st and Site Services has scheduled the project to start Tuesday November 19th pending Council approval. Should weather thwart this plan, in their proposal Site Services has agreed to hold the same price through Spring 2020, when it will schedule an alternative date. Site Services is regarded as responsible and their proposal is responsive to the RFQ guidelines.

The paving will be funded through the MVH Restricted Account 203-30000-63105.

Recommendation: By motion and voice vote authorize the Town Manager to sign the revised Site Services paving proposal in the amount of \$58,330 for the entire alley between Forest and Hohman Avenues from Broadmoor Avenue to Beverly Place.
