

ORDINANCE 1792

AN ORDINANCE CODIFYING POLICIES FOR THE SALE OF TOWN-OWNED TECHNOLOGY

WHEREAS, The Town Council of the Town of Munster is the municipal legislative body of the unit; and

WHEREAS, With the passage of time various ordinances, codes, procedures of the Town of Munster must be amended; and

WHEREAS, With the passage of time various practices, policies and procedures must be updated; and

WHEREAS, The Town Council desires to codify various Town policies and procedure with regard to the sale of Town-issued iPads; now, therefore, be it

ORDAINED By the Town Council of the Town of Munster, Lake County, Indiana as follows:

1. That a Town Council Member or Clerk-Treasurer finishing his or her term and not returning to serve a subsequent term has the opportunity of purchasing his or her Town-issued iPad for fifty-percent (50%) of the launch-date price or identified market price – whichever is less – as one of the benefits provided to the Council Member or Clerk-Treasurer.
2. That Ordinance 1792 is hereby codified and serves to amend the Town of Munster Salary Ordinance to provide that all Council Members and a Clerk-Treasurer finishing their term and not returning to a subsequent term have the opportunity to purchase their Town-issued iPad for fifty-percent (50%) of the launch-date price or identified market price – whichever is less.

And be it further **ORDAINED** that the above-referenced Ordinance Codifying Policies for the Sale of Town-Owned Technology is hereby enacted.

ORDAINED and ADOPTED by the Town Council of the Town of Munster, Indiana, on the 23rd day of December 2019, by a vote of four in favor, none opposed, and one abstention.
