Town of Munster Fireworks Ordinance

• Consumer fireworks may be discharged within the corporate limits from June 29th through July 3rd, and from July 5th through July 9th between

the hours of 5:00 p.m. and two hours after sunset.

- Consumer fireworks may be discharged on July 4th in between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and midnight.
- Fireworks may be discharged on the user's property, the property of someone who granted permission to use their property, or at a special discharge location. Residents are not allowed to discharge fireworks in the middle of the street.
- Individuals less than 18 years of age must have an adult present while discharging or in possession of a firework.
- Violators of this ordinance can be cited by the Munster Police. If you would like to report a violation of this ordinance, please call 911 and an officer will respond to the area. Please provide the location of the potential violation to the dispatcher.

The Munster Police Department asks that residents respect their neighbors and use caution when discharging fireworks. For information about the Town of Munster's planned festivities

LEAVE FIREWORKS TO THE PROFESSIONALS

• The best way to protect your family is to not use any fireworks at home. Instead, attend pubic fireworks displays and leave the lighting to the professionals.

 If you plan to use fireworks, make sure they are legal in your area.

BE EXTRA CAREFUL WITH SPARKLERS

- Little arms are too short to hold sparklers, which can heat up to 1,200 degrees. How about this? Let your young children use glow sticks instead. They can be just as fun but they don't burn at a temperature hot enough to melt glass
- Closely supervise children around fireworks at all times.

TAKE NECESSARY PRECAUTIONS

- **Do not** wear loose clothing while using fireworks.
- Never light fireworks indoors or near dry grass.
- Point fireworks away from home and keep away from brush, leaves and flammable substances.

BE PREPARED FOR AN ACCIDENT OR INJURY

- Stand several feet away from lit fireworks. If a device does not go off, do not stand over it to investigate it. Put it out with water and dispose of it.
- Always have a bucket of water and/or fire extinguisher nearby. Know how to operate the fire extinguisher properly.

entire family will be available, including emergency contacts.

- Address Details First responders can help you faster when you provide address details about your home.
- Medical Information Avoid dangerous drug interactions or allergic reactions by listing your medication and conditions.
- Animals Keep all members of your household safe by including pets, livestock, or service animals that responders need to be aware of.
- Vehicles Having the description and license plate of your vehicle can quicken response in an accident or if you need help while in your vehicle.
- 99% of Smart911 users would recommend Smart911as an essential tool for personal safety.
