

Job Opening

The Town of Munster Indiana seeks a Maintainer II (entry-level laborer) in its Water/Sewer Division of Public Works. New hires typically start at beginning of wage range (\$17.50 to \$24.97 hourly) but depending on specific experience, certifications and knowledge a higher starting wage within this range or within the higher range of Maintainer III (\$19.22 to \$27.44) is possible. Position is open until filled.

Responsibilities

Reports to Water/Sewer Division Supervisor. Typical duties: Maintain/repair underground pipe systems that collect/store/distribute potable water, storm and wastewater; repair catch basins; install/repair valves, meters and hydrants. May read water meters and take water samples. Sweep Town streets. Seasonal demands or emergent priorities often require sharing Street Division duties of: repair streets, patch potholes, seal cracks, mow grounds, maintain facilities, chip wood, brush/leaf pickup, mosquito control, trim trees, install signs, plow/treat snow & ice.

Qualifications

Must be available for overtime call-out. Must be trainable to operate heavy construction and maintenance equipment that might include: backhoe, front-end loader, vector truck, sanitary line inspection camera, heavy roller, wood chipper, trailers, snow plow and other heavy equipment/tools.

Must speak, read and write fluent English. HS diploma/equivalent required and prefer five years experience in a Public Works environment. Need a valid State CDL Driver's License with Air Brake endorsement (within 3 months of hire). Possession of Water Certification as a DSL and WT2 is preferred and will merit increased pay. Must pass drug/alcohol test and background check.
